1. TSIS implements a comprehensive a curriculum adopted and adapted from that of Singapore Ministry of Education to provide a strong foundation for students in the primary school, with emphasis on English Language, Chinese language, Mathematics and Science. Thai Language is included in accordance to the requirements of the Ministry of Education, Thailand. At the end of Primary 6, our students will be sitting for the International Primary School Leaving Examination (iPSLE). The school has been an approved center for iPSLE since the start of academic year, 2015/2016.
2. In 2016/2017, we have launched our secondary school using the curriculum based on the Cambridge International Examination (CIE).

At the end of Secondary Year 2, our students will take the Check-Point Test administered by the CIE. When our students are in Secondary Year 3 and Year 4, they will sit for the International General Certificate of Education (IGCSE). Thereafter, our students will sit for the Advanced Subsidiary level exam (AS level) and Advanced level exam (A level) upon their completion in Secondary Year 5 and 6 respectively.

Our students will graduate with a Secondary Year 6 certification, alongside with IGCSE, AS, and A level qualifications.

3. TSIS invites applicants for the full and half scholarships. Please refer to the Terms and Conditions under 4 below:

4. **Terms and Conditions for the TSIS Scholarships:**

- 4.1 The scholarships are open to students who have completed Primary 6 education at standards similar to that of the primary 6 standard of that of Singapore schools by July/August 2020. Applicants will have to submit the school results and will be prepared to sit for assessments set by TSIS. There will be a maximum of 10 awards per year to successful applicants based on the results and the interview.
- 4.2 Full-Scholarship Awards of 100 % of the tuition fee
- 4.3 Half-Scholarship Awards of 50 % of the tuition fee
- 4.4 A student who achieved an average score of 85 % in English, Maths, Science, and Chinese exams is qualified for a full scholarship.
- 4.5 A student who achieved an average score of 80 % in English, Maths, Science, and Chinese is qualified for a half-scholarship.

- 4.6 The short – listed applicants will have to attend an interview with a school selection panel.
- 4.7 The scholarship covers only the tuition fee. All other fees are payable as per normal with other students.
- 4.8 The award of the Scholarship is for a period of 6 years leading to IGCSE, AS, and A levels. However, at the end of each academic year of Secondary Year 1 and Year 2, the awardee must produce creditable results, to the expectations of the school, scoring an average score of 85% in 6 subjects: English, Math, Science and another 3 subjects from the 4 subjects - Geography, History, Literature, or Chinese. Those who get the half-scholarship must get an average score of 80% in 6 subjects, as mentioned above.
- 4.9 If the awardee’s performances in the final exam of the third term examination of Secondary Year 1 or 2 do not meet the expectations mentioned under point 4.8 above, the school reserves the right to terminate the award of the scholarship in the subsequent year. However, in the next academic year, if the awardee’s performance at the 3<sup>rd</sup> term examination meets an average score of 85% and 80% in 6 subjects, the awardee will get back the scholarship, similar to the previous year.
- 4.10 At the end of Secondary Year 3 and 4 examination, the awardees of the full or half-scholarship must get 80 % or 75 % respectively in 6 IGCSE Examination subjects, including English, Mathematics and one Science subject.
- At the end of Secondary Year 5 and 6 examination, the awardees of the full or half-scholarship must get 80% or 75% respectively in all AS and A level examination subjects taken.
- 4.11 The scholarship holders should show exemplary behaviour. Any misbehaviour which could tarnish the good name of the school may result in the termination of the scholarship.
- 4.12 The school shall have the final authority over the interpretation of the terms and conditions of the scholarship, and will not entertain any queries pertaining to the approach used in awarding the scholarships. The school reserves the right to review the terms and conditions of the award and the decision made is final. The scholarship is not convertible to cash.
- 4.13 The school will only publish the names of the shortlisted candidates who passed the first and second screening of the scholarship test. Raw scores, percentage or letter grade equivalent of the applicants’ scores are considered confidential.

6. The qualifying examination for the scholarship will be held on **Saturday, 20<sup>th</sup> June 2020** from 8:30 to 16:00 hrs.

7. Candidates are to sit for English Language, Mathematics, Science and Chinese Language.
8. The application fee per candidate is 2500 Baht, with lunch provided.
9. Shortlisted candidates will be notified through email by **3<sup>rd</sup> July 2020**.
10. Short listed candidates will be interviewed on **17<sup>th</sup> July 2020**.
11. Successful candidates will be notified by **24<sup>th</sup> July 2020**.
12. Successful candidates have 5 days to report to school to pay for the miscellaneous fees from **27<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> July 2020**.
13. For those receiving full-scholarship, each scholar will receive a total of nearly 2 million Baht worth scholarship for the entire 6 years programme.
14. For those receiving half-scholarship, each scholar will receive a total of about 1 million Baht worth scholarship for the entire 6 years programme.
