#### **SPACE has been launched!**

The Secondary Programme for Advocacy and Community (SPACE) Engagement is a programme under the Secondary Division initiated to enhance pupil discipline and values formation, and to facilitate necessary community-based engagements and experiences deemed necessary for secondary students' social awareness, exposure, involvement, ultimately, and growth.

Since the dissemination of the information to all secondary students, at least two (2) groups of students have heeded to the call of creating space for social involvement.

A group of Secondary 1 students created FoodQuest for Charity, and successfully conducted their food and drinks fundraising drive on October 19th - 22nd. They have raised approximately THB38,000 in total and will be donating the proceeds to Baan Fuengfah, a home for disabled babies, on December 9th.

The TSIS MUN-AI Society group, on the other hand, initiated a schoolwide donation drive which ran for the entire month of November.

They called for donations of preloved clothing and toys, and school supplies to be given to the residents of the Tawanmai Children's Home on December 3rd.

# SUBJECT FEATURE Kideroartev E.L.S.


